## **Admission Policy**

### **Admissions Policy**

The school adheres to the admission policy as written by the Local Authority as written by the Local authority. A brief summary of the policy is shown below. Fuller details may be obtained from the main office at the school.

#### **Nursery**

Children may apply for their child's name to be placed on a waiting list from the beginning of the school year. (1st September to 31st August) in which the child has his/her second birthday. A form can be collected from the main office or accessed on the website. The form must be returned to the main office at the Collierley Primary School.

There is no catchment area for places but policy dictates that preference will be given to children who live within the administrative area of Durham Local Authority.

All children have equal access to places in Nursery regardless of race, gender, religious belief, intellectual, physical, social or cultural background. Criteria for admission to Nursery is based on age.

Children are admitted after their third birthday depending on the number of spaces. Attendance is normally on a part time basis. Children are offered three hours from 8.45am until 11.45am and 12.15pm until 3.15pm daily.

#### **School**

From September 2016 the admission limit at Collierley Primary School is **28**. As a maintained Primary school in Durham Local Authority all admissions are made directly through the Local Authority. The number is 03000 260000 and request Primary Admissions.

However, we do encourage parents to contact school and make an appointment to view the school before completing admission forms.
