School

We will:

- Provide emergency childcare for workers whose work is critical to the COVID 19 response.
- Ensure that children are safe and secure in school.
- Inform parents if there is a confirmed case of coronavirus amongst school staff or children attending.
- Ensure that all adults working in school practise social distancing.
- Ensure that all children and adults wash their hands regularly.
- Ensure that the restricted areas of school which are utilised by the childcare facility are cleaned regularly.
- Ensure that children are not sharing cups, pencils and are provided with gloves and appropriate handwashing where necessary.
- Restrict the number of adults which the children come in to contact with on a daily basis.



- Not send my child in if they display any of the symptoms of Coronavirus – cough, temperature, difficulty breathing –even if I think this is down to another condition.
- Follow self-isolation guidance for 14 days, for the whole family, should anyone in the house be displaying symptoms.
- Ensure my child is dropped off and collected by a responsible person. **No child should be coming in unsupervised, even our year five and six pupils.**
- I will contact school if I do not need the place, please ring school or email a.mcdermid@collierleyprimary.co.uk or p2208.admin@durhamlearning.net
- I will not enter the school building. I will pick up and drop off from the side gated entrance. I will keep social distancing rules (at least 2metres) during this time, avoiding contact with each other.
- I will ensure that I practise regular handwashing recommendations.
- I understand that my child's place will be withdrawn, if we do not follow the guidelines set by the government for social distancing.

- I understand the risks that school staff are taking by providing the emergency childcare and will not act in any way that puts them at further risk.

I have read and understood the emergency childcare agreement. I will abide by the key principles and continue to act within the continuously changing recommendations of the government and Public Health England.

I understand that the guidelines and obligations to children, parents and staff are constantly changing and will always follow the guidelines current at that time.

I will ensure that my son / daughter abides by the same principles and guidelines.

I understand that if I act outside of these that my child will be unable to attend the emergency childcare provided by school staff.
